Family Preservation & Reunification Services (FPRS) provide in-home, community-based, intensive services to reduce safety risks jeopardizing children's placement in the home.



*Our services are designed to:*

- *Help families remain safely together.*
- *Divert children from being placed in foster care or a residential treatment center.*
- *Assist in the reunification of children from out-of-home placement.*
- *Improve family relationships.*

FPRS Services are provided to families in crisis with a child at imminent risk of out-of-home placement or to families with a child returning from placement.

Services aim to increase safety and improve family relationships by:

- *Providing wraparound services designed to build supports for each family.*
- *Teaching parenting, household management, relationship-building and other skills to family members.*
- *Strengthening family members' voices in their own treatment and goals.*
- *Collaborating with community partners to coordinate care for families.*
